Powers Field Trip Participants

Minutes From the June Meeting:

134 people attended the meeting which started at 6:40 PM. Introductions around the room were heard. Treasurer Chris Sutherland gave her report and Joanna deLorraine read the minutes from the May meeting. There was no advertising report: Heather sent a note to Bill saying everyone that went on the Powers field trip that Scott lead had a blast. Bill was reminded of the field trip to the Valentine Mine, Harrisville, which will still be planned for a future date. Bill said that Dino wrote to him with extensive reports on what minerals we have on inventory for "Mineral Kits for Kids" complete with recommendations for those minerals we need to replenish. He completed an inventory of the florescent stock and what we'll need to replenish for that stock as well. He gave a detailed report of what purchases he needs the club to approve.

The club approved two flat rate boxes of fluorescent Willemite and calcite from NJ; price includes shipping, \$100.00 value. Also approved 72 batteries and paper bags for the kids hunt. Chris will take care of getting more egg cartons for the Mineral Kits. Scott, Chris and Andy Sutherland. will purchase the minerals for the door prize drawings at the Syracuse Show. \$150.00 was authorized for Door prizes and \$150.00 for "mineral kits for kids". 100 bases for the signs have been ordered (and received) at a cost of \$245.35. Tshirts are charcoal grey this year. You must sign up and work at the show to receive a free T-shirt. Gary Garlough, show chair, will call to ensure that the Marine Corps Building will be available for use and also call on extra tables to be delivered Friday for the show. The \$25.00 Madrid permit fee was paid for this year; President Bill again stated we must get this done early in the year from now on. The reason for this is simple. The town board votes on whether or not to approve the permit. We cannot run the risk of having our show cancelled in June (!) after we have lined up vendors and published fliers. We will have a special work meeting the 29th of July during which we'll affix the "show dates" numbers on the yellow show signs. Afterwards we'll distribute the signs and bases for "dispersal throughout the North Country, Hither and Yon". It sure gets the word out easily and conveniently and is far-reaching in geographic coverage. Our Tshirts should be ready by then too. This is a Wednesday. Bring glue guns, etc. Same time as regular meetings, 6 pm. 8 people went on the field trip to Powers for Black Tourmaline and Quartz. Bob will buy the donuts and make the coffee both days of the show. Jerry Curcio will lead the field trip to Bush on Sunday of the show we will try to contact Fred Haynes possibly for Sat. to Powers. It was noted that the bracelets for the field trips do not stick well, we decided to still use them up and use tape to stick. Potsdam Geology Dept. will help with geode cracker and mineral identification.




