



Mineral of The Month: Agate






### Agate - The Stone of Perception + Inner Strength.

Agate is a variety of Chalcedony and comes in a wide array of colors and types.

Agates are often striped or speckled and typically somewhat translucent.

Agates are high luster gemstones and are rated a 7 on the Mohs hardness scale. Agates typically occur as the banded form of chalcedony although other varieties are common as well, chalcedony being the microcrystalline form of quartz or silica.

Agate minerals have the tendency to form on or within pre-existing rocks and are most commonly found as nodules within the cavities of volcanic rocks. These cavities are formed from the gases trapped within the liquid volcanic material forming vesicles. [6] Cavities are then filled in with silica-rich fluids from the volcanic material, layers are deposited on the walls of the cavity slowly working their way inwards. ☐ The first layer deposited on the cavity walls is commonly known as the priming layer. 8 Variations in the character of the solution or in the conditions of deposition may cause a corresponding variation in the successive layers. These variations in layers result in bands of chalcedony, often alternating with layers of crystalline quartz forming banded agate. [6] Hollow agates can also form due to the deposition of liquidrich silica not penetrating deep enough to fill the cavity completely. 

Agate will form crystals within the reduced cavity, and the apex of each crystal may point towards the center of the cavity.

Agates have also been found in sedimentary rocks, normally in limestone or dolomite; these sedimentary rocks acquire cavities often from decomposed branches or other buried organic material. If silica-rich fluids are able to penetrate into these cavities, agates can be formed. (Wikipedia)



- Laguna Agate: Highly praised for its intense banding, colors and chatoyancy, or 'cat's eye' effect. Near Chihuahua City, Mexico.




 Dryhead Agate: found in Montana between the Big Horn River and Pryor Mountain ranges. Named after many bison skulls found near the site.








