Longtime club member (since age 11) Gary Stacy passed away on Tuesday October 8th, 2013 at the Albany Medical Center surrounded by his loving family. He was born January 256, 1951 in Watertown and lived in Gouverneur for many years. Gary was a teacher and coach. Sherry lives in Ft. Myers Florida in the winter months.

Gary reminded us during one of our recent meetings that the club used to award scholarships to college students enrolled in mineralogy courses in the local colleges, SUNY Potsdam and St. Lawrence University. To that end we voted to award a \$1000 scholarship this year as well, \$500 to go to Potsdam and \$500 to St. Lawrence. Prof. Kelson at Potsdam suggested to me that we implement the award in this way: the St. Lawrence Co. Rock and Mineral Club will purchase 4 Petrology textbooks to be awarded to the top 4 mineralogy class students in the previous semester. We can insert inscriptions into each of the textbooks as we deem fit; in this instance I think it would be most appropriate to craft an inscription in memory of Gary's inspiration. In this manner the scholarships would benefit the maximum number of students, perhaps provide some incentive to strive a little bit harder in the field of mineralogy, and provide some level of interaction of our membership with students in mineralogy and geology at both colleges. The idea would be to implement a similar program at St. Lawrence University.
